



"I know not what course others may take; but as for me, give me liberty or give me death!"

Patrick Henry, March 23, 1775

At the Second Virginia Convention, held within the hallowed walls of <u>St. John's Church</u> in Richmond, Patrick Henry ignited the flames of revolution with his legendary speech. His words galvanized the Virginia delegation, leading to a resolution that committed Virginia troops to the Revolutionary War.

250 years later, on March 23, 2025, St. John's Church and VA250 brought history alive with a series of reenactments in the very spot where this pivotal moment unfolded. This program featured keynote addresses from VA250 National Honorary Chair Carly Fiorina and filmmaker Ken Burns, making his first public appearance to promote his newest and highly anticipated documentary PBS documentary series "The American Revolution" premiering November 16, 2025. The event was livestreamed and is now archived on the VA250 website.


